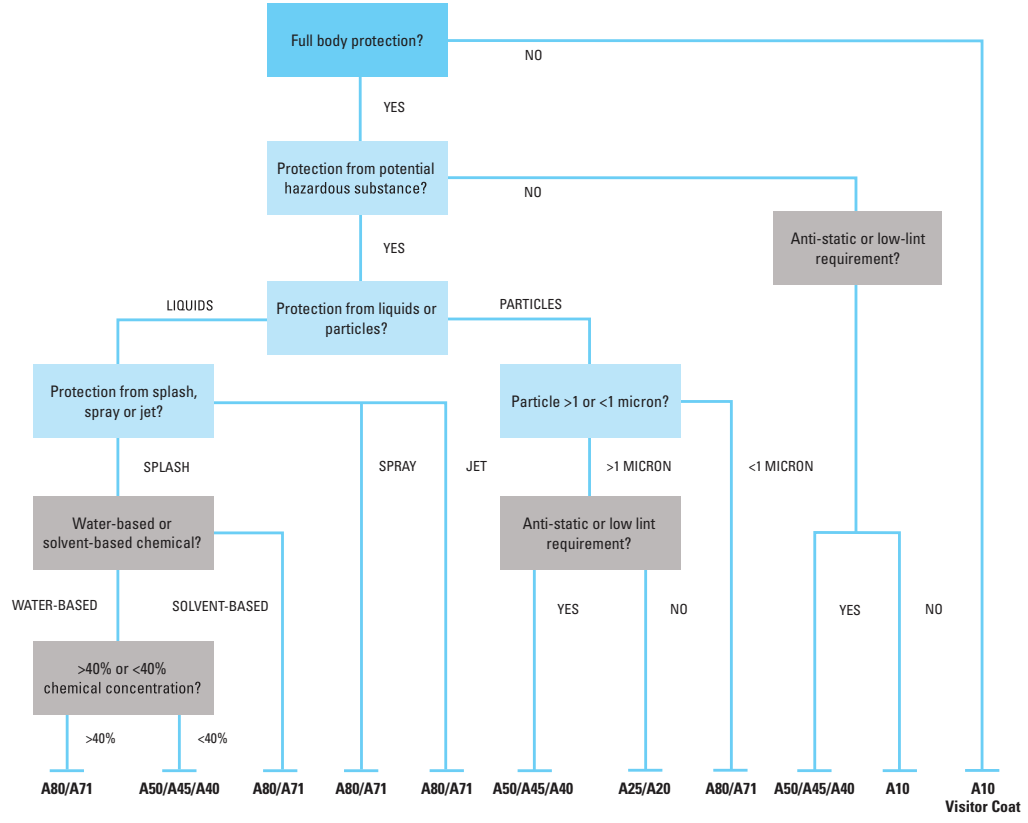


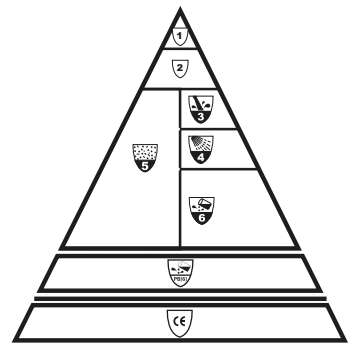
Selecting the right apparel
